NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. The reported violations were discussed with you on December 17th and 21st, 2010. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and/or sold approximately 2 packages of spring rolls containing pork, 4 packages of steamed buns containing pork and 3 Banh Coun containing pork, with no State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling to Battambang Asian Market, Greensboro, NC and/or Burlington Oriental Market, Burlington, NC for the sole purpose of resale to the general public.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or uninspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or uninspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
