NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. The reported violation was discussed with you on February 17th, 2011. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you processed, stored, offered for sale and/or sold approximately 24 pounds of pork hocks, beef shank meat and/or pork meat with bread crumbs, with no State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling to the general public. In a signed statement dated February 17, 2011 you admitted to further processing the afore mentioned meat products into individual consumer size packages and in turn offering for sale and/or selling the meat products to the general public without the required marks of inspection and labeling.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or uninspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or uninspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
