NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on March 7, 2011. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had received, stored, offered for sale and/or sold 488.25 pounds of goat meat, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed Shipper's or Receiver's Certification dated March 7, 2011 you stated that you purchased the goat meat, which was identified as "Not For Sale", from Ms. Jackie Palmer, Dark Cove LLC, Cullowhee, NC and in turn cooked and sold it to the general public who dined at your restaurant.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
