NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. The reported violations were discussed with you on December 6, 2010. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, transported, stored, offered for sale and/or sold eleven (11) packages of pork blood, beef leg bones and/or Laab "beef salad", which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated December 6, 2010 you stated that you purchased the afore mentioned misbranded meat products from an Asian lady but you did not know her name, address or telephone number. You also stated that you cooked the pork blood in your home kitchen and transported it to your store for the sole purpose of resale to the general public.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or uninspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or uninspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
