NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law and the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. The reported violations were discussed with you on June 24, 2011. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, offered for sale and/or sold rib eye steaks, ox tails, pork barbecue, turkey sausage and chicken nuggets, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated June 24, 2011 you admitted to repacking the above mentioned meat and poultry products (with the exception of the pork barbecue) into plastic bags, without the benefit of inspection, for the sole purpose of resale to the general public. You also stated you had been selling the misbranded meat and poultry products to the general public for the past 2 years.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or uninspected poultry products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties and that the sale of misbranded and/or uninspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to these violations. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or uninspected poultry and meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
