NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Poultry Products Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on May 13, 2014. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, offered for sale, and sold fully cooked Lemon Oregano Chicken entrees, which did not contain a State (N.C.D.A.) or Federal (U.S.D.A.) marks of inspection or required labeling for the sole purpose of resale to the general public. In a signed statement dated May 13, 2014 you stated that you offered for sale and sold the misbranded fully cooked Lemon Oregano Chicken entrees for the past year without the benefit of State (N.C.D.A.) or Federal (U.S.D.A.) inspection or required labeling for the sole purpose of resale to the general public.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products is a violation of the North Carolina General Statutes (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.56 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
