

**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on December 10, 2012. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had stored, offered for sale and/or sold eight (8) one pound packages of pork longanesa sausage, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. You stated in a signed Shipper's or Receiver's Certification that you purchased the longanesa sausage, which was packed in zip lock type plastic bags, from La Reina Foods, Kannapolis, NC but further investigation by MPID compliance officers did not reveal that.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
