

NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on December 20, 2011. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored and provided approximately 50 pounds of ground beef, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, to Harris-Robinette Farms Inc., Pinetown, NC. You stated in a signed statement dated December 20, 2011 that Robersonville Packing Co. failed to apply a USDA mark of inspection and required labeling to the above mentioned ground beef.

Please be advised that the processing, storing, providing and/or selling of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
