NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on November 20, 2014. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, offered for sale and/or sold misbranded cooked pork barbecue, which did not contain State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) marks of inspection or required labeling, wholesale to another retail store for the sole purpose of resale to the general public. In a signed statement dated November 20, 2014 you stated you have stored, offered for sale and sold cooked barbecue without benefit of state or federal inspection for approximately six (6) months to Nahunta Store and Tire, Nahunta, N.C. and Pikeville Tire and Gas, Pikeville, N.C. for the purpose of resale to the general public.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statutes (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat and/or poultry products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
