NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on August 21, 2014. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had processed, stored, offered for sale and/or sold pork sausage rolls and bacon and egg pies, which did not contain a State (N.C.D.A.) or Federal (U.S.D.A.) marks of inspection or required labeling, to the general public. In a signed statement dated August 21, 2014 you stated that you purchased the pork sausage rolls and bacon and egg pies from Mr. Rob Berry, owner/operator of Robbylicious Pies, 9465 Burmester Lane, Mint Hill, North Carolina, which did not contain a State (N.C.D.A.) or Federal (U.S.D.A.) marks of inspection or required labeling. The meat products were in-turn offered for sale and sold to the general public.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
