NOTICE OF WARNING

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on April 28, 2016. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had purchased fully cooked fried pork skins from an unknown man from Newton Grove, North Carolina, then stored, offered for sale and sold the misbranded /non-inspected fully cooked fried pork skins to the general public without benefit of State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) inspection. In a signed statement dated April 28, 2016 you stated that you stored, offered for sale and sold misbranded/non-inspected meat products to the general public for approximately two (2) months.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
