**NOTICE OF WARNING**

We have an investigative case report showing that you violated the North Carolina Compulsory Meat Inspection Law. This reported violation was discussed with you on October 18, 2015. Specifically, our investigation revealed that you had transported and stored misbranded/non-inspected raw beef and raw pork sausage to the Vintage Village Flea Market, Hamptonville, N.C., where in turn you cooked the beef and pork sausage and prepared it into a ready to eat entrée, offered it for sale and sold it to the general public without benefit of County, State (NCDA) or Federal (USDA) inspection. In a signed statement dated October 18, 2015 you stated you had processed, stored, transported, offered for sale and sold misbranded/non-inspected meat products without the benefit of county, state or federal inspection for the approximately for approximately two (2) weeks.

Please be advised that the sale of misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products is a violation of North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) §106-549.23 with civil and/or criminal penalties. Please be advised that you will not receive any further warning with regard to this violation. If you should continue to sell misbranded and/or non-inspected meat products, we will pursue legal action against you to invoke the penalties associated with these continued violations. I certainly hope this expensive action will not be necessary. An officer from this department will visit you periodically to verify compliance.
