Re: Changes in Licensing and Examination Fees

With the signing of the 2010-2011 State budget by Governor Beverly Perdue on June 30, 2010, the General Assembly has mandated **increases** in the examination and licensing fees under the North Carolina Structural Pest Control Act. These **increases** effective on July 14, 2010 are as follows:

Examination Fees*

Certification Exams - **\$25.00** per phase (P, W, F)
No fee for the Core exam

License Exam- **\$50.00** per phase (P, W, F)

*Exam fees should be paid with check or money order

*There will be no walk-ins allowed at exam sites.

Individuals must pre-register for exams 10 days prior to the exam date

Fees for Cardholders

Registered Technician (RT card)- **\$40.00** for new card and **\$25.00** renewal

Certified Applicators (CA card)- **\$50.00** for new card and/or renewal


License (Lic) - **\$200.00** for first phase

\$75.00 for each additional phase

The licensing year remains from July 1 of one year through June 30 of the following year.
