1. I have had _____ years experience in the service, installation, repair, and maintenance of LP-Gas measuring devices and affirm that I understand and will comply with the applicable sections of the Gasoline & Oil Inspection Law (Chapter 119 of the NC General Statutes), North Carolina Gasoline & Oil Regulations (Title 2, Chapter 42 of the NC Administrative Code) of the North Carolina Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services, and to the General and Liquefied Petroleum Gas Liquid Measuring Devices Code Sections of the currently adopted edition of NIST Handbook 44.
2. This registration applies to minor repairs to registers, or replacement of register heads, where the gear ratio is not in any way altered or changed, and when the meter is placed back in service.
3. This registration applies to any other work on the meter when the calibration is affected. The owner or operator must be informed the meter requires calibration and may not be placed in service until a calibration is performed by a certified technician.
4. This registration does not include authority to repair, adjust, or break seals on temperature compensators unless the requirements of item 3, above, are followed.
5. I fully understand that my registration is subject to revocation due to misrepresentation of fact, incompetency, or failure to render satisfactory service on my part.

6. I will seal all service and repairs with a lead and wire seal stamped with a 'bulldog' sealer with my initials on one side and the current year on the other.

A lead and wire seal as described above must be attached before this application can be processed.

7. I will notify the director's office of the fact that I have serviced or repaired an LP-Gas meter, giving the name and location of owner/operator, date service rendered, a brief summary of work done, and my registration number, and mail or fax this notice the same day service or repair is made.
