



New Certification & Training Rules November 2024

For Licensed Applicators who Supervise non-Certified Applicators

In November 2024, new regulations became effective that enhance pesticide safety training and set standards for the supervision of non-Certified Applicators (nCA). These changes include:

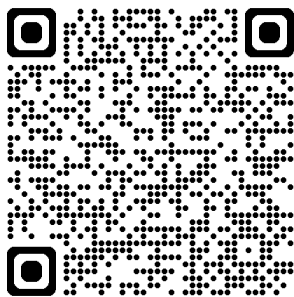
- Each nCA must receive the approved training every 12 months.
- Supervisors of nCA's must maintain approved training records.
- Each nCA must be at least 18 years of age.

The new regulations, approved training video, and recordkeeping templates are available in English and Spanish on the NCDA&CS website and at the QR codes below.

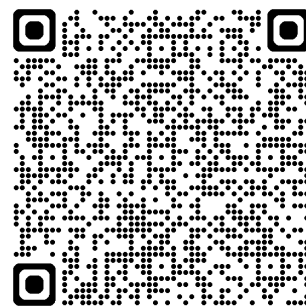
For Pesticide Dealers

Dealers must now keep a record of the categories of the Licensee who purchases Restricted Use Pesticides (RUPs).
