This letter is to confirm my visit to your establishment on \_\_\_\_\_ and our conversation concerning the selling of non-inspected, misbranded and/or adulterated poultry or poultry products.

As I explained to you under Section § 106-549.56(a)(2) of the North Carolina Poultry Products Inspection Law, it states:

"(a) No person shall:

- (2) Sell, transport, offer for sale or transportation, or receive for transportation, in intrastate commerce,
  - a. Any poultry products which are capable of use as human food and are adulterated or misbranded at the time of such sale, transportation, offer for sale or transportation, or receipt for transportation; or
  - b. Any poultry products required to be inspected under this Article unless they have been so inspected and passed;"

This means any poultry or poultry food products you offer for sale in your store or place of business must first be inspected and passed and bear an accurate label to that effect.

At this time, I must ask that you cease and desist from selling any non-inspected, misbranded and/or adulterated poultry or poultry products in the future.
