Pet waste receptacles are designed to encourage pet owners to pick up after their animals in parks, neighborhoods and apartment complexes so as to prevent waste from being transported off-site by stormwater runoff.

Policies

- 2. Each receptacle must include appropriate signage describing the use and purpose of the receptacle.
- 3. Cooperators can only receive cost share assistance on waste bags at the time of the original contract.
- 4. A maintenance plan is required for this practice.
- 5. A receptacle is made up of a bag dispenser or container and a trash can.
