

## ATTACHMENT 10

### SUPERVISOR TRAINING CREDIT SUMMARY REPORT AND ACTION RECOMMENDATION

NC General Statute 139-7.2 requires all supervisors to obtain six Supervisor Training Credits (STCs) per term of service. In addition, NCAC 59A .0301 (d)(2) requires the Division to provide the Commission a summary of STCs by February 1 of odd years.

For the 2020-2024 terms, there were twelve supervisors that did not achieve the required 6.0 STCs; six of these individuals were re-elected or conditionally re-appointed for 2024-2028 terms:

The Division recommends sending these six individuals to the Inquiry Committee established under 02 NCAC 59A .0302 for consideration. *It should be noted that Supervisors Yutzy (McDowell) and Dalton (Surry) only served less than a year of the 2020-2024 term.*

The Division will contact these individuals and ask for a written explanation for their lack of training credits; if there has been a hardship (illness, financial, familial obligations or circumstances beyond the control of the Supervisor) this will be of interest to the Inquiry Committee in its deliberations.
