

Careless debris burning is the leading cause of wildfires in North Carolina

Check for any **burn bans** or **fire restrictions** in your area.



Make sure you have a **valid burn permit.**

Don't be careless. Be ready.

Watch the weather. **Never** burn on dry, windy days.



Keep your burn pile small not tall. It is illegal to burn anything other than natural

vegetation.



Trash must be hauled away to a trash or recycling station.

Never use any flammable liquids to speed up debris burning.

Keep available:



- Bucket
- Steel rake
- Shovel (Keep a phone nearby.)



Never leave a fire unattended. Call to report a wildfire.
