## **GENERAL RULES**

- 1. Entrants must be the producer of the wine, cider, and/or mead.
- 2. Wines earning medals will be displayed at the NC State Fair in the Expo Building.
- 3. Only amateur winemakers residing in NC are eligible to enter non-commercial wines.
- 4. Fruits/juices must be home prepared. Wines from concentrates or kits are ineligible.
- 5. Entrants must submit one (1) 750ml bottle or two (2) 375ml bottles of each entry and must be submitted in corked or capped bottles. A copy of the entry form must accompany entries for shipment/delivery.
- 6. Wine that is a blend of grapes and other fruit will be judged in the category of the predominant ingredient. A wine that is 90% Sauvignon Blanc and 10% Peach will be judged in the Vinifera/Hybrid White Blends category.

  - b. Per entry please include percent of variety(ies) of fruits and/or honey, style, percent residual sugar level, and location grown if applicable.
  - c. Please ship/deliver bottles to the address above prior to October 7, 2024.

## **JUDGING**

All categories are eligible to win the following awards: Double Gold, Gold, Silver, and Bronze. Judges evaluate entries using the American Wine Society 20-point scale:

<u>Overall</u>	2 points max
Finish	3 points max
Taste	6 points max
Aroma	6 points max
Appearance	3 points max
