Gypsy Moth Program - Regulated Articles

- * Outdoor household articles (OHA's) include any article with a household that has been kept outside the home. Examples include outdoor furniture, firewood, garden equipment, dog houses, barbecue grills and recreational vehicles.
- * Logs, pulpwood and wood chips.
- * Mobile homes (includes any vehicle other than a recreational vehicle, designed to serve, when parked, as a dwelling or place of business) along with associated equipment.
- * Trees with roots, shrubs with roots and persistent woody stems (unless greenhouse grown throughout the year).
- * Trees without roots (cut Christmas trees).
- * All other products, articles or means of conveyance when it is determined that any life stage of the gypsy moth is in close proximity and that the article(s) present a high risk of artificial spread of the gypsy moth.
- * Special emphasis will be given to the following articles:
 - Firewood
 - Recreational Vehicles
 - Quarry products
 - Bark mulch
