# Impaired & Impacted Streams Initiative (IISI)

#### Program Background:

- Late 1990s, the SWCC created an opportunity for select districts to survey waters impaired by agricultural sediment on state 303(d) list (initiated by NCASWCD)
- Pilot study completed on six impaired streams in Anson, Union, Craven, Clay, Surry, and Rockingham counties
- Grant funds obtained to fund survey-identified BMP projects on ag lands







# Impaired & Impacted Streams Initiative (IISI)

#### Program Background:

- Survey opened for use by all districts; more grants funds obtained to implement identified projects
- In 2007 the SWCC began annually earmarking a portion of ACSP funds for the Impaired & Impacted Streams Initiative



# Existing IISI Eligibility Criteria and Allocation Process

- Current eligibility criteria for District participation:
  - Complete one or more IISI survey responses (surveys last 5 yrs)
  - Request IISI funds annually through Strategic Plan submittals
- Annual IISI allocations for eligible districts follow ACSP fund allocation guidelines and procedures in rule (02 NCAC 59D .0103)
- No mid-year voluntary return and re-allocation process is available for IISI funds







# IISI Workgroup

**Objectives:** 

- Determine potential changes to IISI funding request processes
- Determine potential changes to IISI funding eligibility/allocation processes
- Identify training/planning resources to develop for the IISI program
- Make recommendations to the TRC







# **Opportunities for Program Improvements**

- See approximately 30% rollover of IISI funds annually
- Annual IISI allocations per district are low (\$5K \$12K)
- Significant District interest in setting up a mid-year voluntary return of IISI funds for supplemental allocations (Feb. 2022 surveys)
- Long survey with redundant or unneeded questions
- 30% of Districts receiving IISI funds have multiple surveys (4+) diluting targeted BMP implementation
- Most Districts receiving IISI funds are not completing targeted outreach in locallydetermined IISI watersheds (Feb. 2022 surveys)
- No performance parameter in place to discourage requesting and not using IISI funds







# Workgroup Activity

- Considered district survey results (Feb. 2022), successful program implementation needs, opportunities for improvement, feasible and reasonable changes to implement
- Updated FY24 IISI program survey fewer questions, fix confusion areas, capture only most useful data
- Made program change recommendations considered by TRC and SWCC







## Approved IISI Program Changes

- A mid-year voluntary return and re-allocation process for IISI funds will be implemented in FY2024 (<u>runs in conjunction with ACSP Spring</u> <u>Supplemental Allocation</u>)
- District eligibility criteria for participation in the IISI program has been updated
  - Phased roll out will begin in FY2024

\*\*Annual IISI allocations for eligible districts will continue following ACSP fund allocation guidelines and procedures set in rule (02 NCAC 59D .0103)\*\*







## IISI District Eligibility Updates – FY2024

- NEW Complete the FY2024 IISI Survey ; previous submitted surveys will not be accepted
  - Twenty-one questions total
  - Data/materials required to be consulted are linked
  - New resources available on IISI webpage
- **EXISTING** Survey responses must indicate:
  - Impairment or water quality degradation from agricultural activity

### IISI District Eligibility Updates – FY2024

- **NEW** Complete all IISI-related questions in Strategic Plan submittal
  - Prioritize <u>up to three</u> HUC-12 scale watershed(s)
  - Affirm those watersheds are prioritized in the district's ACSP ranking form
  - Affirm there are outstanding CS/II requests in those watersheds
- EXISTING Request IISI Funds through Strategic Plan







### IISI District Eligibility Updates – FY2024

- NEW Demonstrate high utilization of IISI allocations either through <u>encumbrance</u> totals by fiscal year end OR <u>voluntary return</u> of funds prior to mid-year supplemental allocations.
  - DSWC to begin tracking IISI allocation encumbrance and voluntary returns in FY2024
  - Plan to be phased in gradually (fully by FY2026) allowing time for districts to improve performance
  - > 70% utilization with one recent FY allocation in last 2 years
  - > 85% utilization with two recent FY allocations in last 2 years
  - Eligible regardless if no II allocation in last 2 fiscal years
