
# **Program Goals**

- Clearing waterways and maintaining drainage infrastructure to reduce flooding impacts.
- 2022 Funding Priorities:
  - Vegetative Stream Debris Removal
  - PL-566 Watershed Structure Repair
- \$38 million allocated by NC Legislature






# **State Wide Allocations**





# Progress

- As of September 1:
  - 2,212,626 linear feet of stream debris removal completed
  - Repairs completed on 12 PL-566 structures.
  - \$14,981,469 paid in reimbursements.
- 16 Projects Closed Out





# Reallocation

- Supplemental reallocation of \$1,376,716
- Eligibility Criteria
  - Current StRAP grantees
  - Expended at least 75% of initial contract funds
  - Not reached \$500,000 per grantee cap
- Awarded to 18 grantees in May 2023










# **Lessons Learned**

#### • Limited staff time

- Grantee responsibilities: identifying sites, working with landowners, selecting & overseeing contractors, preliminary inspections, reporting
- Working with County
  - Bidding & selecting contractors
  - Processing payments
  - Plan early and meet with county






# Lessons Learned

#### • Permitting and/or Engineering

- Not part of every StRAP project
- If required, plan early
- Initial work completed under budget
  - Additional segments can be added to project, but must be approved by DSWC
  - Have waitlist for additional sites
- Land Access Issues
  - Have alternate sites planned





# **Moving Forward**

- 2022 Contracts last until 12/31/2024
  - Final reports due by March 1, 2025
- 2nd Round of Funding
  - Anticipate \$20 million in FY2023-24 State Budget
  - Information sessions will proceed application period
  - Potential allocation in March
